Housing, DeKalb

Our 3rd annual Fall Charity Poker Run is set for Saturday, November 13 (14th raindate or winddate). G.T. Brown again is the master of ceremonies for this event which this year will benefit IAHD, a past and worth beneficiary. Events will include a picnic lunch, the famous Poker Game for a fin and Speedcheck.

IAHD a nonprofit organization that finds permanent affordable housing fo homeless/ lowincome families. It helps with rent and utilities on a short-term basis; and long term with budgeting, job skills and comprehensive social services. Each family has the option of buying their totally rehabilitated house after a few years through a lease/purchase arrangement and then conventional mortgage. The focus is not only in rehabing and providing affordable housing but in fostering the skills required to remain independent...

Everyone is urged to come to Lake Lanier and participate. (Please note: This event is for entertainment purposes only. All proceeds go to charity. The club bears all expenses. Every dollar you contribute goes straight to the source.)

If there is no wind on Saturday but a great forecast for Sunday or if it's raining, we'll do it Sunday. Call G.T. (678) 945-4343 or check the website if in doubt.
